

## Feature Auction: Auction of CÆLESTIS biodynamic wine in aid of WWF...

A special auction of 5 lots of a unique bottling of Chateau Fonroque 2009 in association with Dreweatts 1759 & Bloomsbury Auctions. The wine was bottled for Cælestis, an organisation seeking to raise awareness of biodynamic wine. All proceeds of the sale will go to the WWF.

Caelestis's director says:

'Each bottle is presented in a special handcrafted case made of recycled antique wood next to an award winning photograph dedicated by the CEO of the WWF UK (each photograph is different).

Cælestis is the first brand ever created in the long history of Bordeaux Grands Crus Classés to honour the WWF (World Wildlife Fund), which has just celebrated its 50th anniversary.

This Cælestis bottling comes from the 2009 vintage, considered one of the best Bordeaux vintages of recent times and originates from the prestigious Château Fonroque Saint-Emilion Grand Cru Classé. It is dedicated by its renowned producer and oenologist Alain Moueix who says: "Thanks to the vine stock which is the true artist who captures music of the Stars and the vitality of the soil, I work towards achieving an authentic and harmonious wine."

Out of the total 176 Bordeaux Grands Crus Classés, there are only 4 organic wines (including 3 bio-dynamic wines) making Cælestis one of the rarest bio-dynamic Grands Crus Classés wines, not to mention its symbolic and original label dedicated by the Oscar-winning composer, JAN A.P. KACZMAREK who is also the founder of the "Transatlantyk" – Poznan International Film & Music Festival: "Pure wine brings great inspiration to my music".

The fruit of such inspiration - "Cælestis Impromtu" donated to Cælestis will be heard for the first time before the Cælestis auction begins. There will be a brief pre-sale talk by Alain Moueix of Château Fonroque and Patrick Laine - the WWF UK Representative.
